Therefore, it is crucial that we take precautionary measures worldwide.

To that end, as a citizen of Thailand, I hope for a legally binding comprehensive law in order to cover all sorts of conflicts and root out any possibility of war. This could be done by supporting the Declaration of Peace and Cessation of War (DPCW). The DPCW was written by International Law Peace Committee of the Heavenly Culture, World Peace, Restoration of Light (HWPL), comprised of international law experts, for achieving sustainable peace on March 14, 2016. Through its 10 articles and 38 clauses, the DPCW details the specific provisions for preventing and ending wars, maintaining peace, and realizing complete peace in the global community. Furthermore, it is an integrated solution that presents the role of education, culture and civil society to perpetuate peace. With the DPCW, conflicts will be gone and everyone will live in a peaceful world.

As a youth who is born in Thailand, I strongly feel the duty and personal responsibility to protect this country on this day and age. We do not want to pass on a dangerous world and distress for the future generation. Just like myself, young people, including people of Thailand from all over the world are doing various peace activities to promote and welcome the DPCW. In more than 4 states of Thailand, young people have already been working to create awareness of peace, the values embedded in the DPCW, to youths through youth empowerment workshops, peace walks as well as peace campaigns.



For the DPCW to be a legally binding document as an international law, it needs to gain two thirds of its members for decisions on security council. I respectfully ask Your Excellency to support the DPCW on behalf of this country when it is submitted to the United Nations.

Your Excellency, your support will guarantee happiness for the Thai people and even for the whole of mankind. We hope that you would show your support for this initiative. And, after reading this letter, we kindly urge you to write a letter with regards to world peace, in order to show your utmost support. We would be waiting for your sincere letter about supporting DPCW.
